PAINTING:

Western Millcraft Inc. must ensure that the paint shop which is used to apply flammable substances, has adequate ventilation in accordance with Part 26 and that the ventilation is:

- Adequate to remove flammable vapors, mists, or powders to a safe location
- Interlocked with the spraying equipment so that the spraying equipment is made inoperable when the ventilation system is not in operation
- Must ensure that the paint shop will not ignite a flammable substance
- Must provide a nozzle guard for use with airless spray machinery

INSTRUCTIONS AND RULES:

Western Millcraft Inc. must ensure that:

- Workers are fully trained in painting applications
- Workers must follow the manufacturer's recommendations on how to use the product
- Workers must follow the manufacturer's specifications on how to use the equipment
- All ignition sources are eliminated or controlled
- All equipment is grounded
- Working area is well ventilated
- Warning signs are in place
- Workers practice good housekeeping
- Workers use proper personal protective equipment (PPE) when painting - gloves, safety glasses etc,
- Workers use the proper dual cartridge mask when painting
- MSDS sheets are available in the paint shop
- Workers should spray away from their breathing area and into the exhaust fans if applicable
- Workers must clean up and store paint in accordance with manufacturer's specifications
- Workers must dispose of old paint and thinners in containers designated for hazardous waste disposal
- Fire extinguishers must be in the paint shop at all times
