SUPERVISOR RESPONSIBILITY	To facilitate and/or provide proper instruction to their employees on protection
	requirements and training

	Work site inspection
WORKER RESPONSIBILITY	Use only certified/approved extension cords
	2. Only use on a temporary basis and when necessary
	3. Use cords with proper grounded three-pronged plugs when possible
	4. Use Heavy duty extension cords when required
	5. Extension cords used outside should be specifically designed for outdoor use
	6. All use the appropriate length of cord for the task
	7. Always insert plugs fully so that no part of the prongs are exposed
	8. Do not overload cords
	9. If a cord feels hot to the touch, stop using it and throw it away
	10. Frayed, cut, or damaged electrical cords must be disposed of
	11. Electrical cords should not be used around liquids or in wet area
	12. Don't drive over, or roll equipment over a cord
