WORKER RESPONSIBILITY	1. All ladders shall be inspected prior to performing a task
	2. Wooden ladders shall not be painted
	3. Conductive metal ladders or wire reinforced wooden ladders are not permitted in
	energized areas
	4. Ensure surface is level and firm
	5. Ensure ladder is tied off and set at the proper angle
	6. Ladders shall not be climbed higher than the second step from the top
	7. Three points of contact should always be maintained when climbing up or down
	8. Ladders should not be erected on boxes, tables, scaffold platforms, man lift platforms,
	or on vehicles
	9. A ladder shall not be placed against an unsafe support
	10. Use all ladders according to Manufacturer's Specifications
	11. Inspect rungs for defects such as cracks, broken or loose
	12. Transport ladders in a secure manner with tie downs
	13. Remove all damaged ladders and destroy
